### **Today's Question:**

**What's the best bag for a long-haul trip to Nepal?**

My wife and I are traveling to Nepal soon for a friend's wedding. We are looking for luggage to travel with. My preference is an expedition duffel that I can easily carry on my back and my wife prefers something she can roll. We also both need a carry-on that can double as a bag to carry items in around town, including a Nikon D40 camera. We will be doing significant sightseeing in and around Pokhara, but nothing overnight. What are the best pieces to suit our needs for this trip?

Hmmm. That's a tough one. For you, probably something like the Osprey Sojourn 28" Wheeled Convertible Pack (\$289). Not a duffel, but a big suitcase (4,800 cubic inches) that has both wheels and zip-away padded shoulder straps so you can throw it on your back if need be. Lots of organizer pockets, retractable handle, all the features that make a good travel piece.
