The Osprey Syncro Series is a new collection of hydration packs designed for hiking and cycling. Syncro packs share a number of features designed to keep them lightweight and ventilated. The packs have multiple pockets to stow gear and reflective details for nighttime safety and visibility. To ventilate, the packs have EVA foam with large holes for breathability and spacer mesh prevents irritation. The series is priced from \$99 with the Syncro 10, \$109 with the Syncro 15 and \$119 with the Syncro 20.

Osprey has branched out with their first child carrier. Employing technology from Osprey packs, the Osprey Poco Series is designed to be lightweight and breathable. The seat adjusts for the best fit and balance while the child is protected with padding all around the framing of the carrier. The carrier is designed to fold easily when traveling or storing. A trampoline tensioned mesh backpanel follows contours to promote airflow. The pack is designed to adjust between parents for individual fit.
