Osprey Sponsors Climb Against the Odds

This June, Osprey Packs was one of the sponsors for 2012 Climb Against the Odds, the Breast Cancer Fund's annual mountaineering expedition for breast cancer prevention.

Osprey was responsible for outfitting the team of 27 women, all of whom have been touched by cancer, with Ariel 65 backpacks for their climb of the 14,179-foot Mount Shasta, located in Northern California. Twenty-one of the climbers reached the summit.



Now celebrating its twentieth year, the Breast Cancer Fund has led 12 Climb Against the Odds mountaineering expeditions around the world. The \$400,000 raised by this event goes to support the organization's work to eliminate the environmental causes of breast cancer.

This ascent marks the seventh year that Osprey has sponsored the event.
