The pitch: The Osprey Syncros are streamlined hydration packs designed for cyclists who value light weight and ventilation. Syncro packs are available in 10-liter, 15-liter or 20-liter volumes. Each pack features Osprey's AirSpeed suspension for the ultimate in ventilation while riding. A high-visibility rain cover can be deployed from its own hidden compartment. Storage is plentiful, with a roomy main compartment, as well as a zippered front pocket containing organizer pouches for tools, pumps, cameras and other riding essentials. All Syncros include Osprey's 3-liter HydraForm reservoir to keep the water load stable. Price on the Syncro 10 is \$99, Syncro 15 is \$109 and the Syncro 20 is \$119.
