5. Hi-Tec Women's Apollo

shoes \$75 While Hi-Tec's shoes have always performed well, they've also been a little bland aesthetically. been a little biand aestriectally. Which is why wellke the sneaker-inspired Apollos so much: on-trail performance is exceptional (snug fit, grippy outsole, breathable uppers), and they're light (ten ounces) and agile enough for trail running, hi-tec.com
