OSPREY IMPROVES ON ITS TRAVEL BACKPACK AND DUFFEL PRODUCTS



Cortez, Colo. – For the Fall/Winter 2014 season, **Osprey Packs, Inc.** has made improvements on some of its key travel backpack and duffel bag products: the Waypoint/Wayfarer as well as the Porter and Transporter series. These updates focus on enhancing comfort and usability, as well as providing storage for tablets and laptops.

For deluxe travel backpacks, Osprey will offer the Waypoint and Wayfarer, which – in addition to being highly adjustable – are designed to fit men and women respectively. Priced at \$280, each backpack uses Osprey's suspension technology from the Volt and Viva series. They also come with a removable daypack called the Port Day, featuring a sleeve for a tablet with a touch-sensitive film window.

The company has also augmented its Porter Series of deluxe duffel bags by adding a pocket to the front panel for storing a laptop, tablet or other essentials. The series will now also include a smaller 30-liter size bag for easy travel, with a suggested retail price of \$110.

The Transporter Series, which offers a wider range of duffel bag sizes, has also been updated for 2014. Each bag will boast a large U-zipper for easy access, numerous pockets for organization and a main handle that can change into a shoulder harness. The largest 130-liter size is priced at \$115.
