Whether you are driving or flying, reaching your adventure destination often involves transporting around tons of gear. Monster duffel bags make great haulers but they aren't always easy to lug around airports, on and off trains, or up a dirt trail. Numerous pack and luggage brands are answering the call to make our gear hauling process a whole lot easier.

The Fall 2015 Shuttle Series from Osprey answers our call to adventure with two different sized rolling duffels. These monster gear haulers use a combination of padded sidewalls and Osprey's StraightJacket system with front panel compression straps to to secure loads and add stability.

The duffels are built into Osprey's 16" HighRoad Chassis with extra large sealed bearing wheels for durability over rough terrain. Plenty of zippered pockets will keep your gear organized—a collapsible lower compartment is great for storing dirty and wet clothes or shoes, boots, and hardware.

The low profile padded carry handles on top and sides help with throwing your duffel in and out of trucks, while a tuck away attachment buckle secures your day pack as you roll through the airport.

The 36" long Shuttle 130L retails for \$320, while the 30" long Shuttle 100L retails for \$290.
