INDUSTRY NINE | TORCH

BOOST 148 HUB | \$575

The Boost 148 hub, when coupled with Boost 148 cranks, pushes the chain line outward by 3 mm (without changing the q-factor) to allow for better tire clearance and stronger wheels. Each flange on a Boost 148 hub is 3 mm farther from the hub center, allowing a stronger spoke-bracing angle. Industry Nine's Torch hub system offers low drag, low weight and great axle compatibility tied into a traditional, "classic" hub. 28- and 32-hole drilling available.

The GoatLink was developed in conjunction with Wolf Tooth Components to improve 1x10 drivetrain performance and longevity by increasing chain wrap by as much as 53 percent on a 42-tooth cog. It replaces the direct mount link on 10-speed Shimano Shadow+ derailleurs. The U.S.-made link installs in moments with a 5 mm allen wrench.

TIOGA | SPYDER STRATUM

Breaking away from conventional saddle construction, Tioga's Spyder saddle uses a surprisingly comfortable flexible web cover over a main carbonite structure to create a shock absorbing frame that conforms to your bone structure when seated. The minimalist design is light and durable. Available with carbon rails (120 grams) or chromoly (190 grams) in black or white finish.

Club Ride founder Mike Herlinger believes chamois should be selected based on how long you're in the saddle. The company's new InnerWear has varying densities of chamois—from a 3 mm single-density one-hour pad in the Johnson to a 10 mm triple-density four-hour gel pad in the Air Liner bib. Available for men and women with options for antimicrobial Lycra or stretch mesh fabric.
