EDITORIAL REVIEW

When I first received the Osprey Contrail 22" carry-on, I thought it looked too small to accommodate all my usual clothing and gear. But its sleek design actually leaves more room inside than I expected. The spacious main compartment comes with a FlightLocker clothing organizer, which I found worked best for traveling with a few of shirts and pants. I removed it for more storage on longer trips. A zippered compartment on the back of the bag is perfect for shoes or other bulky items. Because of the curved base, and larger-than-normal wheels, the backside of the bag never dragged on the ground. This design also made the Contrail very stable and the wheels easily rolled over anything I encountered while shuffling through airports. I also appreciated the additional front and top zippered pockets that hold my smaller items. The retractable handle worked well and extended far enough to make the bag easy to pull around. After three months of weekly travel, the construction and fabric still feels and looks new. If the Contrail keeps this up, I'm confident I'll be using it for a very long time.—*Frankie Andreu*
