For the distaff side, one size does not fit all and unisex is not always a workable solution. Osprey recognizes that and carries packs designed specifically for active women who hike, bike or do their trail time in running shoes. The Verve 9 is 17

inches tall and 9 wide, and patterned to be shorter-torsoed and narrower with a shoulder harness created to more comfortably fit the female anatomy. With a LidLock feature for attaching a helmet when not in use, a roomy main compartment with sleeves for tools and pumps (as in air, not shoes), a secondary front compartment with organizers for pens, keys, granola bars, passports, etc., a smaller front quick-access "Shove-It" compartment for stashing rain gear and other small items, a small zippered pocket for miscellaneous items like sunglasses and cell phones, a hipbelt to help anchor and distribute the load and a 3-liter Osprey

Hydraulics reservoir included with tube and mouthpiece, the Verve 9 sells for \$100 in both passion purple or platinum grey (ospreypacks.com; 866-284-7830)
